Personal Easter

The biblical Easter story of over 2,000 years ago has been traditionally taught that it only applied to one man named Jesus. Jesus said no, it applies to each of us in his strong statement that everything He did, we can do to a greater extent. That includes the resurrection and the ascension.

When we look at the resurrection from a spiritual perspective and not a physical one, we begin to get a sense that it may be possible for each of us. When we look at the cross as representing crossing out or releasing our humanness, or our little “i,” there is a feeling of unfolding possibility. The resurrection then becomes the resurrection of the big “I” within us following the release of little “i.”

Charles Fillmore explained the ascension process as moving through physical consciousness, then through mental consciousness and finally arriving and living in spiritual consciousness. The “Good News” of this story is this: not only is it possible for everyone--we have a “playbook” to show us how.
